## 1. INFORM & ENGAGE SHAREHOLDERS

## **OBJECTIVE:** Inform, engage and connect all citizens to our public schools **OBJECTIVE:** Create awareness and support for the district and the Coalition


- Informed more than 1,600 people through 80 community meetings
- Served on numerous committees and boards locally and statewide creating awareness and support for Baldwin schools including chamber of commerces, education foundations and others
- Increased support for the Baldwin Partners program through online registration and increased volunteers to 177
- · Led engagement efforts and coordination of community meetings for district's strategic plan
- Coordinated Literacy Summit engaging more than 75 people and raising more than \$7,200 for the Guided Reading initiative



## 2. PROGRAM GRANTS & FUNDING

#### **OBJECTIVE:** Obtain adequate funding to implement best practices and meet the needs of the district

• Awarded more than \$288,000 for programs and initiatives in Baldwin County schools through restricted grants and donations. An additional \$94,000 was received through engagement of the education foundations for the Guided Reading initiative.



### 3. PROFESSIONAL / LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

#### **OBJECTIVE:** Increase capacity through training and mentorships

- Coordinated GRITC Summer Conference as well as the Leadership Forum for School and Community Leaders day
  providing training to more than 175 people
- Organized Standards for Excellence in Nonprofit Board Governance training from the Alabama Association of Nonprofits for 20 nonprofit leaders

## **OBJECTIVE:** Provide a united voice on initiatives concerning education and nonprofits

- Created messaging and a campaign to inform voters of the 1 mill tax referendum in December. OVER 11,500 people were reached with over 701 INTERACTIONS
- Engaged nonprofit partners to protect public trust in America's Charitable Nonprofits by opposing any efforts to repeal or replace the Johnson Amendment
- Attended meetings for the Alabama Association of Nonprofits Board of Directors
