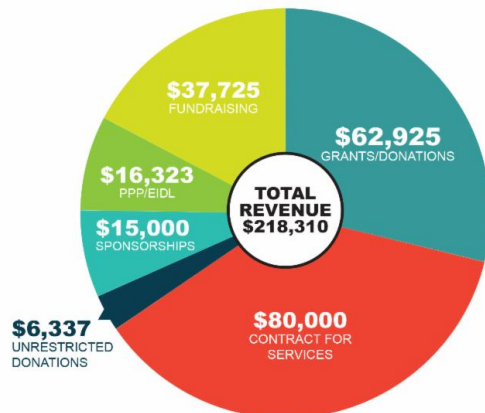

One test, endless opportunities. ACT.

March 9, 2021

ALL high school juniors (11th grade) are required to take the ACT test whether they plan to attend college or not. On March 9, there are no fees to take the ACT.

In addition to the test being a college admissions exam, the ACT includes a profile and education/career planning section to help students plan for life after high school. Students will receive personalized career information and develop a comprehensive profile that tells colleges about their work in high school and future plans. Students can also see their strengths and weaknesses in the subject areas tested to help direct their future education.
