**SCHOOL PARTNER GUIDELINES**

### **INVENTORY:**

- Due to limited space in our warehouse, new inventory is ordered and restocked monthly.
- Once new inventory has been added to Shopify, BCEC representatives will notify school partners to place orders.
- If you attempt to place orders prior to receiving notification, you will likely see a lot of items listed as "Out Of Stock".

### **ORDERS**:

- Orders can be submitted monthly.
- A deadline for order submission will be indicated in the email notification to place orders.
- Orders received AFTER the specified deadline (which is typically the day before order fulfillment) will be batch processed the following month. We attempt to schedule order fulfillment on the last Thursday of each month except on holidays or school holidays.

### **HOW IT WORKS:**

- The school principal appoints one person to coordinate and place MONTHLY orders (preferably the school counselor or social worker).
- The coordinator will consult with the school principal, social worker, counselor and/or nurse to determine what items are needed for their students before placing an order.
- Orders are placed through the Palm Project website, a Shopify platform: https://palmproject.info
  - Select Inventory View available items. Category of items include school supplies, hygiene, clothing, health, household & food/beverage.
  - Add items to the shopping cart like any other online shopping experience.
  - Select Shopping Cart Review your order.
  - Select Check Out Enter your BCBE email address, contact name and school address. You can even SAVE the info so it will remember you the next time you place an order.
  - Select Continue to Shipping No need to add any additional information.
  - Select Continue to Payment No need to add any additional information.
  - Select Complete Order You're done!!
- Orders are filled by Coalition volunteers and delivered directly to your school by BCBE warehouse personnel approximately one week following the order deadline.

### **GUIDELINES:**

- Please order what is needed for the month being mindful that we are supporting close to 50 campuses and we are working to ensure that this service will be sustainable.
- Palm Project is not intended to take the place of any existing program or service that is currently serving students, i.e. backpacks with secret meals or school supplies, clothes closet, etc.
- Pullups and Pediasure are intended for special needs students when parents do not pack enough supplies.
